



Hong Kong Breast Cancer Foundation's Response to the 2020 Policy Address

Mrs. Eliza Fok, Chairman of the Hong Kong Breast Cancer Foundation (HKBCF) welcomes the Government's measures in its Policy Address today that the Department of Health will provide breast cancer screening for eligible women having regard to their breast cancer risk as well as its response to HKBCF's latest Policy Address submission.

The HKBCF considers the initiative, along with the Government's revision on breast cancer screening recommendation in July 2020, is a great leap forward towards having population-wide breast cancer screening in place in Hong Kong.

The initiative is expected to make women at moderate/high risk of developing breast cancer, or women aged 44 to 69 with certain risk factors e.g. history of breast cancer among first degree relative, nulliparity, physical inactivity eligible for mammography once every two years.
