Dr. Lawrence Li graduated from Hong Kong University Medical Faculty in 1983 and started his post-graduate training in surgery at Queen Elizabeth Hospital (QEH). While there, he decided to change career paths to explore radiotherapy and oncology.

During this period, Dr Li also completed additional training in Internal Medicine at the Prince of Wales Hospital (PWH) in 1987, and returned to QEH to continue his career in radiotherapy and oncology. Over the next decade, he also obtained higher qualifications, including his Fellowship of the Royal College of Physicians, Fellowship of the Royal College of Radiologists in UK and Australia, and Fellowship of Hong Kong Academy of Medicine.

Dr. Li completed his post-fellowship training in oncology and radiotherapy in the United States, studying at Harvard Medical School, M.D. Anderson Cancer Center, and Stanford University. In 1994, he left Queen Elizabeth Hospital to commence his private practice, subspecializing in breast cancer, nasopharyngeal cancer and other head and neck cancers.

He is currently a Management Committee Member of Hong Kong Breast Cancer Foundation as well as the Director of Alpha Oncology Centre.
