Graduated in 1985, Dr Yau was trained in Queen Mary Hospital and qualified in both Clinical Oncology and Internal Medicine. He served the Department of Clinical Oncology until 2006 and moved on to Kowloon West Cluster (KWC) and established a new Cancer Centre. In 2016, he retired from the position of Consultant and KWC Cluster Chief of Service in Oncology, and currently is the Associate Director of Comprehensive Oncology Centre of Hong Kong Sanatorium and Hospital.

Dr Yau is a key member in various professional and advisory bodies in relation to cancer management, including the HKSAR Cancer Coordinating Committee, he was also the deputy Chairman of the HA Coordinating Committee in Clinical Oncology and a member of the HA Central Committee in Cancer before his retirement from public service.

Dr Yau was also involved in health care management and clinical informatics development in the Hospital Authority Hong Kong (HA). He was the Deputy Hospital Chief Executive of Princess Margaret Hospital and Kowloon West Cluster Clinical coordinator in Health Informatics before his retirement. He also served as the Chairman of HA Clinical Informatics Program Steering Group and the Chairman of the Clinical Management System Portfolio Steering Committee.
