## Hong Kong Breast Cancer Foundation

Hong Kong Breast Cancer Foundation was set up on 8 March 2005, as a non-profit charitable organisation dedicated to mitigating the threat of breast cancer to the local community through education, support and research & advocacy. Its mission is to promote public awareness of breast cancer and the importance of breast health; support breast cancer patients on their road to recovery and advocate better breast cancer care in Hong Kong.

In the past 11 years, HKBCF has

- supported 63,303 breast cancer patients on their road to recovery
- provided educational talks sharing breast cancer news and knowledge to 50,969 people; provided breast cancer examinations to 20,279 people, more than 8,000 of whom received the service for free
- collected data from 14,387 breast cancer patients/survivors for analysis, facilitating local patients, medical professionals, the public and the government to better understand the disease
