Raising funds for HKBCF Jockey Club Breast Health Centre (Kowloon)

(Press Release, 25 May 2017) “Wings of Hope” gala dinner, a fundraising event benefiting the Hong Kong Breast Cancer Foundation (HKBCF) was held on 13 May at Conrad Hong Kong. The event was organised and hosted by Mrs. Camey Wong, wife of Mr. Peter Wong, and was attended by more than 400 celebrities and community leaders including Chief Executive-Elect **Mrs. Carrie Lam** and her husband **Mr. Lam Siu-por**, wife of the Chief Executive of Hong Kong SAR **Mrs. Regina Leung**, **Mrs. Rita Fan**, **Mr. Canning Fok** and his wife **Eliza**, **Mr. Peter Wong** and his wife **Camey**, **Dr. Lo Ka Shui** and other famous icons from political and business sectors. They all joined to show support for the HKBCF’s work against breast cancer.

HKBCF’s Chairman Acknowledged Support for the New Centre in Kowloon

Mrs. Eliza Fok, Chairman of HKBCF, remarked at her speech that she is grateful for the supports that help the HKBCF extend its service to Kowloon. She thanked the then Chief Secretary Mrs. Carrie Lam for finding a piece of land for the Kowloon service centre, and the HKBCF is so lucky that it received a grant from the Jockey Club Charities Trust for building the new centre and sponsorship of the project. The gala was meant to raise funds for the long-term operation of the new centre from people with a good heart.

The auction session was one of the highlights of the night. Mr. Amigo Choi was invited to host the auction in which guests placed their bids excitingly to support charity. The dedicated programme of fabulous performances added colour to the gala.

The Night Climaxed with Ms. Frances Yip’s Singing

Ms. Frances Yip, a breast cancer survivor and veteran Hong Kong diva, returned from Australia to attend the gala. Greeted by applauses and cheers, Frances sang several touching oldies, including “Seal with the Kiss”, “Yesterday Once More”, “Moon represents My Heart”, and her signature song “Shanghai Beach”, which made all guests get carried away and sing along. The impressive performance and joyous interactions led the charity gala to a climax.

The programme packed with fabulous performances smelt the heart of everyone, and many of the guests were moved to give further support to the HKBCF.

Proceeds of the event will be donated to the HKBCF in support of its new service centre in Ngar Chi Wan, the HKBCF Jockey Club Breast Health Centre (Kowloon), which is expected to come in service in the year. According to the statistics of Hong Kong Breast Cancer Registry, breast cancer patients living in the districts with a lower household income in Kowloon and the New Territories tend to have poorer breast health. In districts like Wong Tai Sin, Kwun Tong and New Territories North and Shams Shui Po, nearly 80% of the breast cancer patients had never had mammography screening, and 18% of them delayed their medical consultation and treatment that led to a higher rate of advanced-stage cases at diagnosis. The figures reflect a dire need for breast health education and breast cancer screening and HKBCF sees an urgency to expand its patient support service and breast screening service to Kowloon and New Territories. “
