Team of psychologists, registered nurses, social workers and breast cancer survivors is dedicated to addressing patients' individual concerns with empathy and experiences. Individual and family counselling are available to breast cancer patients and their families, and peer support groups enable breast cancer patients to obtain support from breast cancer survivors and be inspired by their experiences. Financial assistance for therapy treatments is available to eligible breast cancer patients, who would otherwise be financially deprived of medication. Well-being sessions are offered to help breast cancer patients and survivors take better care of their health after cancer.

Ground floor of the HKBCF Jockey Club Breast Health Centre (Kowloon) houses a clinic with all the medical equipments needed for breast check-ups, and the floor upstairs the Breast Cancer Support Centre that organises activities for members.

Once I entered the Support Centre via the stairs, I saw to my right a glossy long table. As I took a closer look I knew it to be part of an open kitchen area. Given its location near the lobby, the table allowed people there sitting and dining together. I thought to myself that the combined space would make it easier for more members gathering for a meal. “Many members are into dietetics, so cooking class are held here on a regular basis,” the lady in charge told me, “Just by sitting at the lobby makes my mouth water.”

When I walked into the lymphedema therapy room, a member greeted me and shared with me tips of using the compression gloves.

What I saw there reminded me of a quote, “Everything happens through a process, and you can only harvest your fruit only during the process.”

Just take a look at the open design of the activity room and members’ devotion, you will be sure that the ambience will certainly give us more positive vibes.
