

Dr. Eliza Fok (Chairman)



Dr. Eliza Fok is the Chairman of the Hong Kong Breast Cancer Foundation (HKBCF), a position she has held since 2010. As one of the Founding Members of HKBCF and an active participant in fundraising, Dr. Fok is committed to helping those whose lives are affected by breast cancer.

Under the Chairmanship of Dr. Fok over the past 12 years, HKBCF has grown from strength to strength, from a small NGO (16 staff in 2011) to a renowned, highly admirable non-profit organization dedicated to mitigating the threat of breast cancer to the local community through education, patient support and research & advocacy (60 staff+ in Jan 2022)

In 2014, Dr. Fok published a guide book “100 Questions About Breast Cancer” which was based on the information of interviewing over 70 survivors. Dr. Fok also attended a Breast Cancer Conference in Beijing to introduce the book which paved ways for patients’ recovery journey.

On top of the above, HKBCF was the first NGO to get the HKMA Award as well as to offer the first Breast Risk Assessment service in Hong Kong. In 2018, the Foundation's second Centre entitled HKBCF Jockey Club Breast Health Centre (Kowloon) was established in Ngan Chi Wan, Kowloon.

In 2017, Dr. Fok was awarded Leader of the Year by Sing Tao Newspaper Group. She was also conferred the Doctor of Philosophy Degree by the University of Hong Kong in 2021.
