Breast Cancer is the No. 1 cancer among women in Hong Kong. According to the Hong Kong Cancer Registry, Hospital Authority, cases have continued to rise, with 5,585 new invasive breast cancer cases recorded in 2023 - representing a nearly fivefold increase over the past thirty years. While most women recognize the importance of screening, only 20% undergo regular check-ups. Participation rates are significantly lower among grassroots and less-educated groups, who often face financial barriers and a lack of information. These obstacles prevent vulnerable women from seeking early screening, causing them to miss the valuable opportunity for early detection and treatment.

The **Subsidized Breast Cancer Screening Programme for Community Women** provides approved applicants with for the following services:

1. Breast Self-Examination tutorial by healthcare professionals
2. Clinical Breast Examination conducted by registered nurses/ doctors
3. 2D Mammogram to detect breast cancer early

* This programme will provide a subsidy for ultrasound examination on a case-by-case basis according to a doctor's recommendation, or **payment will be required** for any further examinations.

Eligibility: Applicants who are 40-74 years old, HK Permanent Identity Card holders, have never undergone mammogram screening and meet one of the applicant categories as below.

Applicant Categories 1, 2, 3: Fully subsidized; Applicant Categories 4: 50% Co-payment
