



Dr. Carol Kwok is a Consultant Clinical Oncologist at the Department of Oncology, Princess Margaret Hospital, Hong Kong. She also serves as Honorary Clinical Associate Professor in the Department of Clinical Oncology, Faculty of Medicine, The University of Hong Kong, and in the Department of Medicine and Therapeutics, The Chinese University of Hong Kong.

Dr. Kwok graduated from the Faculty of Medicine at The Chinese University of Hong Kong in 1989. She pursued specialist training in Clinical Oncology at Queen Mary Hospital, obtaining her FRCR in 1994, followed by FHKCR and FHKAM in 1997.

With a subspecialty focus in breast cancer treatment, Dr. Kwok has been a core member of the combined breast cancer clinic since qualifying as a specialist. After 15 years at Queen Mary Hospital, she joined the newly established oncology center at Princess Margaret Hospital, Kowloon West Cluster, where she played a pivotal role in advancing multidisciplinary breast cancer care and introduced new patient management practices.

Beyond clinical work, Dr. Kwok contributes actively to scientific symposia, clinical research, resident training, cancer education, and patient support groups. Her research interests include prophylactic growth factors to reduce neutropenic toxicity in docetaxel chemotherapy, anti-emetic therapy, scalp cooling, and analysing neoadjuvant chemotherapy treatment outcome. Her findings have been published in the *Hong Kong Medical Journal* and presented internationally at the St. Gallen Breast Cancer Conference 2023, 2025 (e-Poster) and ESMO Asia 2023 (abstract).
